Subject: Parking Enforcement Hours Reinstated to 9:00 p.m. on Monday.

Ferndale, Michigan – Parking enforcement hours will extend to 9:00 p.m. on Monday, June 3rd. Since early April, enforcement hours have been capped at 8:00 p.m. (sunset) to ensure that adequate lighting is available for downtown patrons using the new Park Plus pay stations. This temporary cap on enforcement has also allowed our Department of Public Works sufficient time to develop and test a portable solar powered lighting prototype that is expected to be implemented by August. Loyd Cureton, Director of the Department of Public Works explained

“We have crafted a solution that will illuminate the Park Plus pay stations with a ‘Pay Here’ sign powered by photocells. The signs will be raised over the pay stations to improve visibility during evening hours. To ensure the solution remains energy efficient, the solar powered photocells will automatically time out when they are no longer needed.”
