

WHERE DO YOUR WINTER 2023 TAX DOLLARS GO?



53¢ Transit 19¢ County/P&R 12¢ 11¢ 5¢ HCMA DIA Z00

The City of Ferndale collects taxes for other jurisdictions and taxing agencies. These assessments are consolidated on your statement for your convenience, with the collected money sent to the other jurisdictions. For each dollar of your winter property taxes:

53¢ goes to Oakland County Transit (0.95000 millage rate)

This operates, maintains, improves, and expands public transportation services in Oakland County.

19¢ goes to Oakland County Parks and Rec. (0.34310 millage rate)

This improves, operates, and maintains parks, open space areas, trails, and recreation activities in Oakland County.

12¢ goes to Oakland County HCMA (0.20700 millage rate)

The Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority operates the 13 Huron Clinton Metroparks in five counties: Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, Washtenaw, and Livingston.

11¢ goes to the Detroit Art Institute (0.19450 millage rate)

This provides funding to the Detroit Institute of Arts for the benefit of residents of Oakland County.

5c goes to the Zoo Authority (0.09450 millage rate)

This provides continuation of zoological services at the Detroit Zoo to benefit the residents of Oakland County.

Other Special Assessments (Varies)

These are unique to each property owner. Things like unpaid fines, county assessments, or delinquent bills may be included in your tax bill.
